Foreign Applicants for Scholarship Stays in Slovakia

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
- **reference to a study stay (1 – 2 semesters) of foreign university students at a Slovak university during their Master Studies**
- **related to a study/research stay (1 – 12 months) of PhD students from foreign universities/research institutes at a university or research organization of the country (PHD study programme in Slovakia during their PhD studies)**

- **related to a research stay of artists, stay of 12 months of university teachers, researchers or artists from foreign universities/research institutes at a university/research organization during their stay in Slovakia**
 - **PhD study programme or other short-term stay of students in Slovakia**
- Foreign students participating in Slovakia and citizens of the Slovak Republic studying or working in the service of research in their countries abroad can apply for the mentioned stays for foreign stay.

Citizens of which countries are eligible?

Citizens of a following countries can apply for the mentioned stays:

- a) the Member States of the European Union
- b) other countries and territories in the following list: Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Iceland, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Kosovo, Palestine, Serbia (including Kosovo), Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, Vietnam, Viet Nam.



- a) Slovakia
- b) Canada, Mexico, USA, Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Jamaica, Nicaragua, Panama, Peru, Puerto Rico, Uruguay, Venezuela, Republic of Korea, Laos, Cambodia, Thailand, Myanmar, Vietnam

What is the amount of a scholarship?

- a) **University students** – monthly amount of 300 € by PhD students
 - b) **University teachers, researchers or artists** – 580 €
 - c) **university students** – monthly amount of 350 €
 - d) **university teachers, researchers or artists** – 650 €
 - e) **university students** – monthly amount of 300 €
 - f) **university teachers, researchers or artists** – 600 €
 - g) **university students** – monthly amount of 300 €
 - h) **university teachers, researchers or artists** – 600 €
- The amount of a scholarship stay stays depends on the length of a scholarship holder.

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply for a stay at www.slovakstays.sk. Since it does not take more than 6 weeks after the deadline. After submitting online application form with all documents, applicant shall send original and copy of his/her application letter to SAIA Bratislava not later than the day of his/her deadline. Information on application forms, required documents and services providing information on application forms can be found on the Programme website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- **20 April by 16:00 CET** – scholarship stays for the next academic year
 - **31 October by 16:00 CET** – scholarship stays for the next semester of the next academic year

Slovak Applicants for Scholarship Stays and Travel Grants Abroad

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
- **reference to a study stay abroad (1 – 2 semesters) or 1 – 3 trimesters of Slovak university students during their Master Studies**
- **related to a study/research stay abroad (1 – 12 months) of PhD students from Slovak universities/research organizations eligible to carry out PhD study programme in the Slovak Academy of Sciences during their PhD studies**

- **travel grants** – financial support for travel costs related to the research for the stay abroad of students of Slovak universities during their Master Studies, during their PhD studies or during their stay in Slovakia for studies during their PhD studies at a university/research organization of a foreign country and the Slovak Academy of Sciences.

Which country can you choose for your scholarship stay?

The Programme can choose to be held in any country. After being awarded a scholarship stay, you can carry out your scholarship stay in any country of the world.

What is the amount of a scholarship?

The amount of a scholarship stay for every country individually shall cover average living costs during scholarship stay. When staying abroad, it is a reference to the living costs and travel and accommodation expenses of other stays. E.g. by Hong Kong.

All www.stipendia.sk activities can be found on each scholarship stay all ready been of online.

What is the amount of a travel grant?

Travel grant is a contribution of related to travel costs in and for the Slovak Republic. It is a contribution of the stay abroad of the stay of students at least once academic year. Services provided by SAIA Bratislava avoid the amount of a travel grant being into consideration up to the grant of the application and financial services of the Programme.

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply for a stay at www.stipendia.sk. Since it does not take more than 6 weeks after the deadline. After submitting online application form with all documents, applicant shall send original and copy of his/her application letter to SAIA Bratislava not later than the day of the stay. Information on application forms, required documents and services providing information on application forms can be found at the Programme website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- **30 April by 16:00 CET** – scholarship stays for the next academic year
- **31 October by 16:00 CET** – scholarship stays for the next semester of the next academic year
